1. Briefly, describe the field experience. What did you learn about technology facilitation and leadership from completing this field experience?

Through this field experience, I was able to learn how to incorporate multiple ways of learning and different opportunities through online/blended units. By designing, developing, and creating an online unit, it taught me the importance of planning and connecting the standards to the learning activities. Since the unit is completely online, it is important to provide detailed information and a variety of ways to gather information. In relation to leadership, the field experience has allowed me to see how careful planning and troubleshooting is crucial when you are delivering information.
